A Brief History of the Dirt

In 1985 the Pattaya Mixed HHH (as it was called then) was brand new, but there was a lot of excitement and interest in the air since InterHash 1986 was going to be held in Pattaya. A guy named Rob Denny from Angeles City used to come and run with us occasionally during this time and he described some special activities that the men only Angeles City HHH had on their runs. This planted the seed and started discussion on Pattaya starting a men only HHH. Another Pattaya Hasher, **Derek Miller**, and I had a habit of jogging together a couple of times a week. On one of these runs we decided we weren't just going to talk any more, we started planning to set run #1. This process took a few months as we decided we needed a good T-shirt design from the get go. Also, veteran hasher **Frank Benfield** insisted we should have a record keeping and book-keeping system. And we needed a name!

The name came when on one of our jogs we decided on the venue for Run #1, a little place called House 150 that used to be just off the middle road near where the 3rd road is now. At that time House 150 was located on a dirt road. As we were at House 150 one day discussing plans for our run, standing in the middle of that little dirt road, the name came to us like an epiphany. With a name finally, I poured myself into the T-shirt design.

With the venue and special activities planned, we set our run and started advertising. We only had 13 people sign up, and one of those was a no-show. The cost of Run #1 was B400, which included T-shirt and software but no food. We budgeted 12 beers per runner. Runs were about the same length as today, but the circle was much briefer. We would slug a beer or 2 until all the runners came in, then straight to the software. The brief

circle would be afterwards. On Run #1 we copied the Angeles City selection process which involved everyone throwing a shoe in a pile.

The old Wild Elephant was the start and end point. Most of us had girlfriends at the time who would be waiting for us at the Wild Elephant. This was the reason for the brief circle and we would always run back to the Elephant from the venue so we arrived dirty and sweating. Boy did we fool them!

Run #2 only had 8 runners and I believe it is the only run that didn't have a shirt. The entire first year was touch and go with small number of runners. The exception was Run #8 which was held the day before InterHash started. We had something like 50 runners, way exceeding our expectations. It was the first run to end up at a soapy and the selection process had all the runners in the fish bowl. Most of the runners on #8 had never even heard of a HHH doing something like that. They were amazed and astounded. The PDRH3 was suddenly semi-famous. But interest in Pattaya waned after InterHash and Run#8. No one else seemed interested in having a run and by Run #12 we had decided it had been a good year and a great experiment, but we named that run "Death of the Dirt". It was supposed to be the final run. But someone came forward and volunteered to have Run #13, "Rebirth of the Dirt". The rest is History. None of us back then would have believed that PDRH3 would still be alive and kicking 35 years later. Happy Birthday PDRH3!

Judge "PIMP" (Founder)

Gentlemen -

I can remember it like yesterday... The Monday Hash had been going on for around a year. Started in 1984, the hash was mixed.

The **Prince of Darkness (Pimp)** decided there needed to be an “All Male Hash”, like they had in the Philippines. So, in August of 1985 I was privileged to be invited to participate in the ground breaking Dirt Road, Run Number #1.

The Dirt immediately became the most exclusive hash in the world. People tried for years to be invited. Too tough for most, a Dirt Road Shirt gave you instant respect at any Hash Event in the world!

In the mid-90s to have a run the waiting list was 2 years!

So, I am very proud to be the Dirt Historian after 35 years of Dirt, and still have my hand painted Run #1 Shirt!

I was on Run #1 We had so much fun I volunteered to be a Hare with **The Prince of Darkness** on Run #2.

Meeting at the “Wild Elephant” 8 Dirt Roaders took off in a monumental flood. We had set the run through a duck farm. So, we were all swimming and trying not to swallow duck shit. The shower at the venue was a 55 gallon drum for everybody.

I told her that I was covered in duck shit and she said, “I don’t mind!”

“Rotten Banana” – The Medicine Man

First of all,

I was very proud to be a GM of the Dirt Road (2013-2015), and I was so very proud to be the first non-English native GM of the Dirt Road!

I always did it with respect and full energy, there is nothing comparable to this men's club, to be so stupid running through the heat and sitting down on ice and getting punished for nothing, but all together, a community of madmen regardless of whether they are rich or poor...

One of my funniest stories:

For better understanding, I was also the Brew-master for many years of the Pattaya Monday Hash.

I do not remember who all the other Hares were on this Dirt Road (so much beer sometimes), but one of the Hares was my good old buddy "**Dog Licks Its Dick**".

The run was over and the Venue was on the parking lot of the Welcome Inn. Dirt Roaders are eating and we prepare the second circle, I ordered my GM stuff and **Dog Licks Its Dick** always mumbled to himself and asked me so many things I do not believe. Then he put the bucket next to the ice and wanted to know what he filled in? At first I thought he was kidding me, but his face was radiant with helplessness, then I screamed - fill the bucket with gold, pure gold...

Of course I then told him that the ice comes in with water, what else, but in the situation it was so scurrilous that I will never forget and we are still friends - Dirt Roaders.

My first Dirt run.

Run #41: It's Finger Lickin' Dirt.

This was July 30, 1988, and it was my first hash run ever!

Back then rules or "traditions" were a bit different. No rules for Virgins to have done so many runs first, or a sponsor with 5 Dirts. Like me, I had only been partying and drinking at TQ for some time, and got an OK from the key Dirt members to come on the Dirt. It was actually another Norwegian, Hans "**Square Head**" (RIP) that suggested that this was for me. And boy was he right, I was hooked right away.

Some details of where we took off from, and transport evades me, but remember the run trail in the jungle, crossing some wet lands and streams, and we were told to look out for chicken, dead ones, and collect them.

One guy found one, think it was "**Flaming Arsehole**"? And he was about to drink a beer through the dead chicken in the circle, but was stopped just before, as someone mention there could be some bad bugs inside after laying a day in the jungle.

We ended up in Rayong, and the circle was held in the parking lot for a soapy place.

As this was my first H3 run ever, I did not have a Hash shirt; I had a shirt saying "Surf Zone" from Hawaii and thought that was cool to wear on the run.

I think it was **Papa Whiskey** that was the RA, and he placed me "surfing" on the ice, flat on my belly, and he showed me body surfing is done, by standing on top of me.

And as he stands on top of me on the ice he says: "Do you know what a surfer always have to look out for? The wave from behind!". And there someone was ready with a bucket of ice water throwing over me, ha ha.

More down downs and fun was to follow, but I don't remember all details.

So I got proper punished on my first run, but the virgin procedures we have now, was not in place yet. The Dirt was only 3 years old, and many traditions were still to come.

One other scene I never forget was on the **“Fire Brigade Dirt” March 08 run #278**, sitting on the top of the big Pattaya fire engine, with shirts made to look like uniform and proper fire helmets, and drinking beer while driving around in Pattaya.

One tour bus with Koreans pulled up beside us at a red light stop, and they went bananas with their cameras 😊 Taking photos of those crazy Pattaya firefighters drinking beer on top of the truck.

And I think it was on **“Born To Be Dirt” March 05 run #241**, that we had to cross a big, but almost dry river, that now was mostly mud, we all were knee or hip deep in the mud, but **Supervirgin** as he is a big man, was deep in mud to his armpit! Crying for help as he was stuck, but no help came, as I guess most were afraid to be dragged under with him.

Maybe this is the time the motto “better him than me” was created?

But somehow, he manages to come out of the muddy river, only losing one shoe if I remember right.

As I said I was hooked with the Hash from my run # 1. And it has formed my life and my way of having fun ever since. Without the hash, and thanks to the Dirt, my life would have been so much poorer in friends, fun, experience, and lots of beer!

Fantasy Island Dirt - Run # 157, 26 March 1998.

Hares: **Stupid Kraut Cunt, Kike Cooker, Peg Leg and Fido Dildo.**

This run was on Koh Larn Island, also the reason for the name it was important to hold the run on an island. We had been out and scouting routes the whole day and finally found a way/path to come up to the top of the mountain. This was hard work and, we were exhausted.

As we have a rest at the top, we start to look for a path or way through the dense vegetation. We could not find any, we kept looking for if we did not find a way down, that would mean the whole struggle to get to the top was for nothing. Also, if we could not find a trail there, that could mean we had to change the theme and the place and everything. But as we stood there not knowing what to do, a monk appears out of the jungle, on a path we couldn't see. We decided to follow him, and a few meters away he has his own gym! It was an open gym on a concrete base, very simple, but he did some skipping and other exercises. I think it was **Peg Leg** that decided to ask him if he could show us the way down, and he agreed to do so for 200 baht.

So after 30 min when he was finish with his exercise, we follow him down on a path, for us invisible, to the bottom of the mountain. We had scratches and were bleeding many places; the monk was barefoot in his Saffron robe, without a scratch!

We made a deal with him that if he was to be on the top of the same mountain, in his gym, the next week, same day same time, we will give him 500 baht. Without him, we will not find the way down again. So next week, we were out laying the paper trail all the way up to the top of the mountain, praying to Buddha that the monk would be there and meet us. And the prayers must have worked, he was there waiting for us!!

So with the help of the monk, we could finish laying the paper trial down to the bottom, and the Dirt was a success 😊

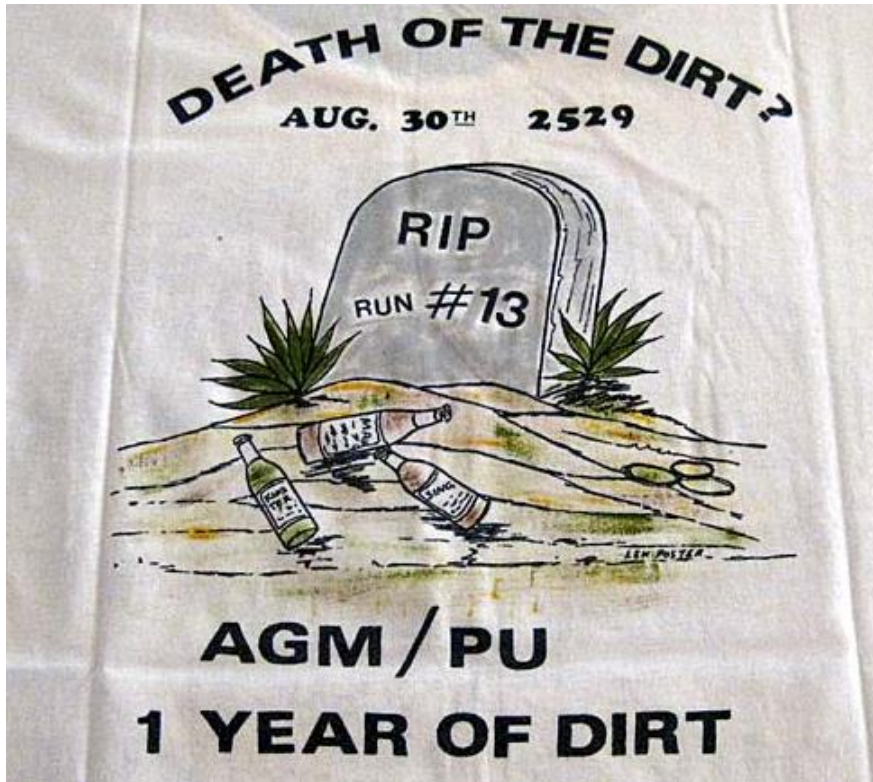

In celebration of 35 Years of Dirt the theme was based around a combination of 2 previous anniversary runs.



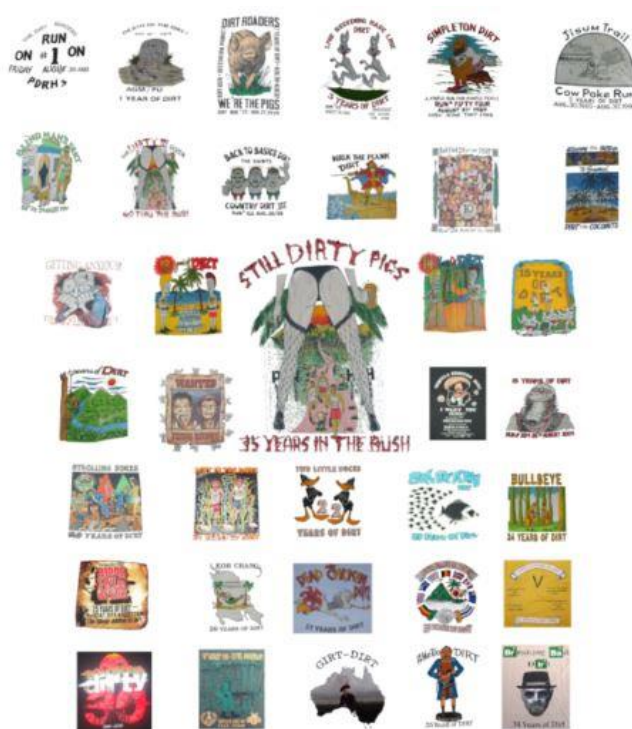

Pattaya Dirt Road H3 - Logos

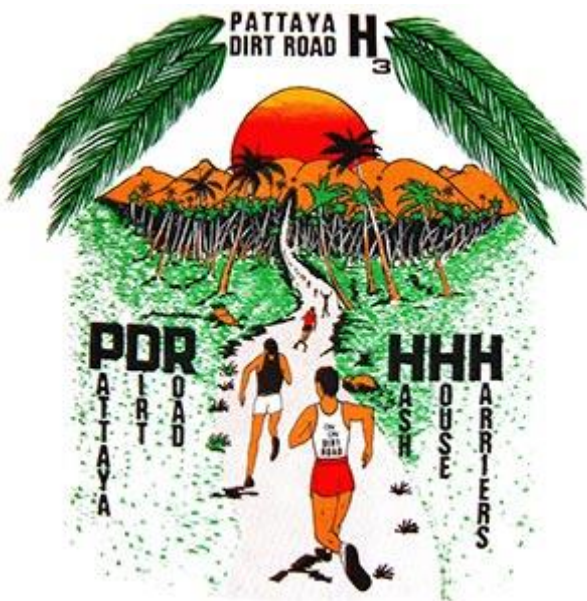
HARES: It is your responsibility to ensure that an official Dirt Logo is used on the T-shirt Front.

Stating which image you need.



1. White Shirt Logo

This is the normal image used when having a large Logo on a White shirt. This can also be reduced in size if needed as a small logo on white shirt front.

2.Black Shirt Logo

This is the normal image used when having a large Logo on a Black shirt, obviously cannot be used on a White shirt.





3. Image used for patches

Can be used as a small logo on shirt or for making patches for back packs. More text can be added as required for whatever occasion.

4. Black and White Logo

Can be used for large Front or small front logo on Black shirts or various color shirts but not on a white shirt.



5. Sepia logo

Can be used for large or small front logo on any light coloured shirts but not on black.
