

In memory of 55 British or commonwealth, 9 American, 7 Norwegian, 4 Dutch, 1 Italian & 3 French aquanauts, who tragically lost their lives while working on & below the North Seas treacherous waters since 1966. In addition, tragically, several non registered deaths occurred & are not listed here. The new frontier explored in the 1970s, 1980s, and 1990s was the bottom of the North Sea, and a handful of saturation divers blazed the trail. Without them, there would have been no North Sea oil and gas exploration, drilling and production. As with all journeys to uncharted territory, many of those pioneers lost their lives. Although regulations, equipment, and safety procedures have evolved and made the job of the North Sea diver far less hazardous today, in the beginning, every descent was fraught with danger. The deep, dark, cold, inhospitable and unpredictable places they had to go made tragedies inevitable. Lamentably they did not make it back home to their loved ones. May they rest in peace.
